



Erasmus+KA2 Project *“Expanding Content and Language Integrated Learning by Using Technologies”*

First Mobility in Latvia -Riga, March 2018

Students and teachers participated in the mobility in Riga from 19th to 23rd March 2018.

SCHOOLS:

- Riga English Grammar School (Latvia)
- Istituto Istruzione Superiore "M. Bartolo"(Italy)
- Pelgulinna Gymnasium (Estonia)

36 students were involved in the mobility activities: 5 students from each visiting partner organization, 21 students from hosting school.

During the mobility **the Italian, Estonian and Latvian students** had a lot of various activities:

- 1) presentation of their country, city, school, participation in ice-breaking activities, preparing and tasting national food;
- 2) students learnt together with partner students, **Riga English Grammar School** provided 10 classes, using CLIL to integrate partner students in their daily schooling, giving and receiving feedback of learning;
- 3) students together made a movie: they decided on a relevant theme, structure, management issues, Created a scenario for the first part of the movie, organized filming and editing. The first episode of the film is called **“DEATH FOR LOVE”**;

4) students had two outdoor lessons in **CINEVILLA** where they took part in filming process and also had an excursion in this unique tourist attraction in Latvia;

5) students had an excursion in **Old Riga**, visited the **National Library** and played bowling in **'Pepsi Boulinga Centres'**.

The Italian, Estonian and Latvian teachers participated in the following activities, during the mobility in **Riga English Grammar School**:

- 1) presentation about **Educational System** of Latvia and role/place of **CLIL** in it;
- 2) international seminar **'Content and Language Integrated Learning at school'**, the workshops were organized by a **CLIL expert, teacher trainer Keith P. Kelly**;
- 3) **workshops** on using **CLIL** (2 lessons);
- 4) **job shadowing activities** for teachers in different classes (16 lessons);
- 5) **CLIL master-classes** and outdoor lessons;
- 6) discussion about the **role of CLIL** in the context of national curriculum;
- 7) excursions in **Old Riga, the National Library and Cinevilla**.
